ODOP Common Facility Center Promotion

About:

The ODOP Common Facility Center (CFC) Promotion Scheme is a key initiative under the "One District One Product" (ODOP) program of Uttar Pradesh. It aims to provide infrastructure and shared facilities to artisans and entrepreneurs engaged in producing district-specific products. The objective of this scheme is to enhance productivity, improve product quality, and create a collaborative ecosystem for artisans.

The Objective of the CFC scheme is to establish a CFC that would provide support in the following:

- Testing Lab, Design Development, and Training Centre
- Technical Research and Development Centre
- Product exhibition cum Selling Centre
- Raw Material Bank/Common Resource Centre, Common Production, Processing Centre, and Common Logistics Centre
- Information, Communication and Broadcasting Centre
- Packaging, Labelling, and Barcoding facilities
- Strengthening of Value Chain

Benefits:

- For CFCs of project cost up to Rs. 15 crores, the State government provides financial assistance up to 90% of the project cost, while a minimum of 10% would be borne by the SPV.
- Financial assistance is given for CFCs of projects costing more than Rs 15 crores, provided the State's share would be calculated on Rs 15 crores only.
- The State government can also sanction capital for projects of a similar nature, previously approved by the Central & State governments, which are incomplete due to the lack of funds. For supporting such incomplete projects, proper justification would be provided.
- Project cost to SPV contribution
 - Up to Rs. 04.00 crore 10%
 - Above Rs. 04.00 crore and up to Rs. 08.00 crore 20%
 - Above Rs. 08.00 crore and up to Rs. 10.00 crore 30%

Eligibility:

- Project proposal detailing the nature of the CFC.
- Identification and business registration documents.
- Proof of residence in the respective ODOP district.
- Contribution proof of 10% of the total project cost.

- Artisans, entrepreneurs, and businesses engaged in the production of districtspecific ODOP products.
- The project must be located within the district identified under the ODOP scheme.
