- Any individual who wants to start a business, particularly in rural and agro-based industries, and is above 18 years old.
- Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) with a valid Udyam Registration.
- Technical institutes, universities, and research centers, especially those focusing on rural and agricultural sectors.

The applicant organisation will select a Mentor Institute and upload the proposal through the selected Mentor Institute as per the prescribed format online at www.aspire.msme.gov.in
